## Participation

Every Team (three competitors in each class – F1A, F1B, F1C, one team manager, one assistant team manager and one timekeeper) from FAI affiliated European National Aero Club (National Airsport Control Organization), individual European Champions 2004: Mr. Yaron KRAUS (Israel) – F1A, Mr. Stepan STEFANCHUK (Ukraine) – F1B and Mr. Evgeny VERBITSKY (Ukraine) – F1C, are invited to participate in 2006 European Free Flight Championships. Supporters, helpers and spectators are also invited to attend.

## Date and Place

July, 16 - 23, 2006, Odesa, UKRAINE.

## Flying site location

Flying site – military field “Chabanka”, 30 km to the East from the city of Odesa by road Odesa-Mykolaiv. Grass area 2x2 km and open space around for 5 km (same place as “Black Sea Cup”).

## How to reach Odesa

- by direct flight from: Athens, Budapest, Istanbul, Kishinev, Kyiv, Moscow, Tel-Aviv, Varna, Vienna, Warsaw;
- by car (freeway from Kyiv);
- by train;
- by ferry from Varna (Bulgaria);
- by express-bus “Autolux” from airport Boryspol/Kyiv;
- by rental car through Avis, Europcar, Hertz agencies in the airport.

## Competition rule

According to the valid FAI Sporting Code, as well as all applicable amendments.

## Sporting licenses

Each competitor must possess FAI Sporting License valid for 2006.



## Official languages

The official languages are Ukrainian and English.

## Organizers

Ukrainian Federation of Aeromodelling, Odesa Region Federation of Aeromodelling, Central Aeromodelling Club of Ukraine.

## Timekeepers

Organizers will provide local timekeepers. Each participating country may enter a timekeeper and these timekeepers will be preferably used. The intention to enter a timekeeper should be announced in the Entry Form. All these timekeepers should speak basic technical English. The Organizers will provide accommodation, meals and Banquet together with the local timekeepers for the full official period of the contest from July, 16 (lunch) till July, 23 (breakfast). They should act in all contest days, attend briefings for timekeepers and have own binocular, tripod and stopwatch.

Each team will have the right to have any of their group act as a third timekeeper on their flights both in rounds and fly offs. Any small team unable to take this option will have a third timekeeper provided by Organizers for their fly off flights.
